Package pick up: Saturday Sept 4 @ Sports Authority Camarillo – 2:00-6:00 pm

Please bring your current USAT membership card with you and a photo id. If you have lost yours you can go online and print a copy of your card. If you do not have a current USAT membership you will be charged for a one day USAT membership of \$10. **Cash or Checks only.**

Can I register for the race at package pick up?

Yes! Cash or Checks only, no discounts on race day.

Please come early so that you have plenty of time to get ready for the race

Race Day packet pickup August 1st At the race site Freedom Park, Camarillo Airport 6:30 – 7:30 a.m.

Race start location: 480 Skyway Dr. Camarillo, CA 93010 Camarillo AirPort, Corner of Eubanks / Pleasant Valley Rd.

Some Race day info and check list:

1. **Race Start:** Long course- 8:00 a.m. Sprint- 9:00 a.m.
2. **Equipment:** All athletes must wear a bike helmet in good working order (NO Duct Tape). All bikes must have handle bar ends in place for safety. Race numbers must be on bike and worn during run.
3. Transition area opens at 6:30 a.m. look for the blue fencing and the “transition” sign.
4. Bring your sun block, running shoes, sun glasses, gloves, tubes, race hat, race belt, and water bottles
5. Bring some friends or family members to cheer you on and maybe take some cool pics of you crossing the finish line.
6. Make sure you turn around at the “turn around” sign that will have a big 16 foot red feather flag next to it near the finish line. **Long Course is two loops** please keep track of your loops.
7. Bathrooms- free standing building just behind transition area.
8. Athlete parking is on Willis Road right next to the transition area and the expo area. We have plenty of room for everyone, but come early for the best spot. Parking is free.
9. Awards Top 3 overall in each race. We will have some cool swag raffle at 10:30 a.m.

Course Conditions:

All Flat and Blazing Fast! The forecast is sunny and hot for this Sunday so come prepared.

Keep an eye out for potholes as you enter Eubanks (orange paint to help you spot them). This is considered an open course, please be mindful of traffic. We will have the signal lights on flashing red for your safety but please keep your head up for any wayward drivers. All riders must stay in the bike lane for the entire course. This is a NO DRAFTING race.

- 7:30 a.m. Race day check in closes
- 7:40 a.m. Pre race Q & A and last minute updates
- 8:00a.m. Long course race starts
- 9:00 a.m. Sprint race starts
- 10:30 a.m. preliminary results posted
- 11:00 a.m. Swag give away.
